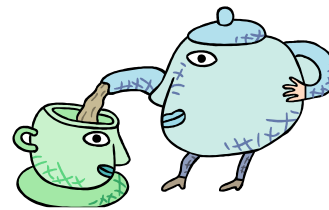

Westin Pasadena Information:

Room rates at the Westin Pasadena are \$169.00 plus 15.065% tax, so rooms are a total of **\$194.46 per night** for single/double/triple or quad. Please note the following regarding early checkout: "In the event that a guest who has reserved a room within your block checks out prior to the guest's reserved checkout date, an early departure fee equal to one half (1/2) the contracted guest room rate will be charged to that guest's individual account. Guests wishing to avoid this fee must advise the hotel at or before check-in of any change in the scheduled length of stay. The Hotel will inform members of your group of this fee upon check-in." Parking rates at the Westin are \$8.00 per day for self-park (no in/out privileges) and \$13.00 per day for valet parking with in-and-out privileges.

Hilton Pasadena Information:

Room rates at the Hilton Pasadena are \$160.00 plus 15% tax, plus a 10 cent per night California State Tourism tax, so rooms are a total of **\$184.10 per night** for single/double/triple or quad. Please note the following regarding smoking rooms: "This is a non-smoking hotel. For attendees in need of a smoking room, guest rooms with a balcony are available at an additional charge of \$30.00."

Parking rates at the Hilton are \$15.00 per day self parking and \$21.00 for valet parking with in-and-out privileges.

- Reminder: The Facility Usage Fee has been **increased to \$50** this year. This fee is charged for each competitor or assistance chorus member who does not stay a minimum of one night in one of our convention hotels. This assessment applies to **all members** of a Region 21 Competing Chorus, Quartet Competitors and the current Assistance Chorus. This fee will help defray any attrition costs incurred by the region due to chorus members staying outside our convention hotels. The fee will be pre-paid and actual hotel check-in lists will be verified against each chorus List of Competing Members, which is turned in at the Chorus Briefing.
- **Requests will be filled in the order in which the hotels receive them.** The deadline for reservations with the hotels is **March 5, 2010.** After this date, rooms will be released to the public. Any request for rooms will then be on a space-available basis at the standard non-group guest room rate.

All of our hotel and facility arrangements are diligently negotiated by our Region 21 Events Coordinator, Helen Erickson. She is not only experienced but has our best interest at heart. We appreciate all the time and energy she uses on our behalf.



REMINDERS

Registration - *New This Year* All name badges will be mailed to the contact person listed on the Registration list which is **due by March 5, 2010**. Each Chapter will then distribute the badges to their pre-registered members in whatever manner they choose. All late registrations, transfers and name changes will be processed at the **Region 21 Registration Table** - also located at the **Pasadena Convention Center**. Chapter-at-Large badges, program pickup, VIP ribbons, miscellaneous information and Golden West Magazine will be provided at the **Region 21 Registration Table**. There will be no sign-in sheets this year so you can quickly get over to the boutique and spend lots of \$\$\$ to support our International Competitors on their way to Seattle. **SEATTLE'S BEST!**

All-Events and Single-Events Tickets – All-Events Ticket registrations (AET) will be available for \$60, Single-Events Quartet Contest tickets for \$35, and Single-Events Chorus Contest tickets for \$40. A special youth rate (18 years and under) will be available for \$15 each event.

Transportation - The Pasadena Civic Auditorium is an approximate walking distance of 10 to 15 minutes from the hotels. Please be prepared for inclement weather. Busing will be provided for competitors only. The current economy has affected us all. One of our largest budget items is transportation and we can no longer provide free shuttle service for the attendees. However ***New This Year*** - Shuttle service **will** be available to **ALL attendees for a fee of \$10**. We will no longer specify a 'physically challenged' description in our registration process. So whether you **'need'** a ride, or simply **'want'** one, we will provide a ride between your hotel and the Auditorium. This \$10 fee **must be prepaid** when submitting the registration form with each member identified in the appropriate column. (see AET form) The name badges of those who pay a Shuttle Fee will be appropriately marked to allow their admittance onto a shuttle. (Reminder: Registration and the Boutique will be located at the PCC, not at one of the hotels)

Open Seating – Seating will be open for both the quartet and chorus contests. This gives us the opportunity to have the best possible audience for every contestant. The first 3 rows across the center sections of the auditorium will be marked as reserved for our VIPs. In the past, VIPs have received seating for themselves and one guest. ***New This Year*** - **VIPs will each receive 1 seat only.** Name badges will designate VIP seating. All other seats will be available for our audience members on a first-come-first-served basis. **We ask that audience members be respectful and keep the saving of seats to a minimum.**

Project Harmony - This year's faculty is the fabulous Dede Nibler. This opportunity for our young women is **free** - so give a gift to girls everywhere! Please visit the Information Center on our Regional website for all of the details. www.region21.org Flyer attached.

Club 21 - The 4th annual Club 21 Spectacular Jamboree will be held on **Thursday night, April 15, 2010** at the Convention Center. The show will begin at 7:30 PM. This annual show is a separate ticketed event and is a fundraiser for Region 21's Club 21. Make your travel plans with this great show in mind and be sure to arrive in Pasadena early enough to attend! Flyer attached.

Education Class - Don't miss "Musical Games for Musical People" with faculty Dede Nibler. This class will be available for all convention attendees who are not competing in the quartet contest on Friday morning. This will be held after the joint Chorus and Quartet briefing and prior to the Mass Sing.

Mass Sing – Come one; come all to the steps of the Pasadena Civic Auditorium. **Gerry Papageorge** has generously agreed to be our **Mass**ter Director again this year. Let's bring her a **Massive** crowd of singers! Since it's right before the quartet competition begins, we'll all be on time! In case of rain we will just step inside and fill the lobby with song.

Celebration - Saturday night we will "**Have It All**"! You'll have plenty of time for a nice dinner out with your friends after the chorus contest. Then at 8:00 we'll start the evening with our **Harmony Showcase Afterglow** hosted by the **Scottsdale Chorus**. And there's more - **Hospitality rooms** available for partying, strolling quartets, and time with our friends. The best of all things Barbershop.

Boutique - Good news for shoppers! You'll be able to do your shopping without worrying about getting from one hotel or another and back to the Auditorium. This year's boutique area will be just steps away - right at the **Pasadena Convention Center**. The Proposed Schedule of Events notes the time changes since Bulletin 1. The Boutique will not be open on Sunday.

Airport, Taxi and Shuttle - The closest and most convenient airport is Burbank, CA (BUR). Transportation from the airport to the hotels is available by taxi or shuttle. Taxi prices are from \$50 to \$60. You can also contact the airport shuttle services directly online at www.SuperShuttle.com or www.PrimeTimeShuttle.com to arrange for group reservations.

Rehearsals and Meals - A forty-five minute flat-floor rehearsal will be scheduled for each competing chorus on Saturday morning. If possible, this can be held in conjunction with a chorus meal function. Meal function times will be based on the order of appearance. Please complete the **Function Request Form** if you wish to have a meal function.

Choruses are responsible for payment of such functions. Menus will be sent to you after we receive your request and the schedule has been established. Please do not contact the hotel prior to that time; they will simply refer you to Helen Erickson. Requests will be accepted based on the order in which they are received. The hotel will require a copy of a credit card (front and back) as a deposit for a chorus meal function. Either a chapter credit card or an individual's credit card may be used.

There are a limited number of rooms available for extra rehearsals following the quartet contest Friday evening. These rooms are available from 8:00 PM until midnight by special request and a fee of \$200.00. Choruses may opt to share the time with another chorus to split the cost of the room. If this is your chorus' choice, you must make arrangements with the other chorus and notify Helen Erickson, EVC, by completing the **Function Request Form** enclosed. Requests will be filled according to the order in which they are received.

Competition Deadlines - Competition Forms were sent by International Headquarters to each President/Team Coordinator on January 4, 2010. Please follow the instructions and observe the deadlines:

- **Quartets:** Competition entry deadline is **February 15, 2010** (late entry date is March 2, 2010 and will incur a fee.) Quartets must have **registered** with International as a quartet by January 15, 2010 in order to avoid additional late fees. [SAI Quartet Registration](#)
- **Choruses:** Competition entry deadline is **February 16, 2010** (the late entry date is March 3, 2010 and will incur a fee.)

Joint Briefing and Inspection: Information and forms regarding our briefings and inspections will be sent to you separately by our Competition Coordinator Extraordinaire, Judy Huffman. Judy has been appointed by International for several years as the CC for Region 21. She gives us her best and her expertise in knowing 'what's good for us' increases annually.

Video Recording: All Master video recordings are processed in DVD format. Your audio performance will be provided on CD at no charge. A Master DVD recording must be purchased from Region 21 (\$35) before any additional recordings are ordered from Bill Stephens Productions. All Video request must be prepaid by **April 1, 2010**. Due to popular request, we again offer the purchase of a 'Director' video this year.

Regional Assessments for all Chorus and Quartet members, as well as Chapter-at-Large Quartet members must be paid by **March 31, 2010**, in order to compete.

Order of Appearance - The draw for order of appearance at International Headquarters will take place on **February 22, 2010**. Each chapter President/Team Coordinator, Director, and quartet will be notified by e-mail as soon as possible.

Trophies - Quartets and choruses possessing regional traveling trophies and plaques are asked to bring them to competition. Now is the time to have them engraved and send the bill to the Regional Finance Coordinator, Charlene Neblett. charlene@neblett.org

In the Event of Rain – Chorus competitors should plan to bring ponchos or large plastic trash bags to protect costumes. There is no room for umbrellas in the traffic pattern.

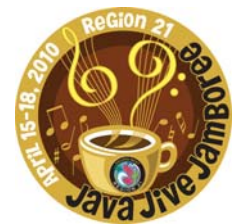
