Fun and Productive Rehearsals: How to Make Rehearsal Time Fun and Productive!

Description: It's easy for rehearsals to get stuck in a rut. Come to this interactive class to participate in a live rehearsal with techniques that make the rehearsal fun and productive. Musical leaders will learn about effective ways to run rehearsals while singers will add tools to their vocal skills toolbox. The Seminar Chorus will be used for demonstration purposes.

Calibrate Your Sound

Description: The purpose of group "warm ups" isn't actually to warm up the singers' voices. Calibrate the sound of your ensemble by creating and using exercises that are specific to the needs of your group.

The Vocal Mechanism: How Does it Work?

Description: Singers have a high risk of developing voice disorders if they are not producing their voices in a healthy manner. This class dives into the anatomy and physiology of the vocal mechanism including respiration, phonation, resonance, and articulation in order to provide the foundation necessary for healthy singing.

Visuals and the Voice

Description: It can be challenging to execute an innovative visual plan that supports strong vocal skills. This class explores the vocal mechanism, how the voice is affected by physical movement, and how to make your voice shine while leveling up your physicality.

Sweeping up the Dust Bunnies

Description: In general how PHX dug into the details to begin to address them.

Keep That Voice Healthy

Description: This class focuses on naturally occurring changes in the voice, vocally abusive behaviors, voice disorders, voice therapy techniques, when to see an otolaryngologist or speech-language pathologist, as well as what to do and what to avoid to keep the voice healthy.
